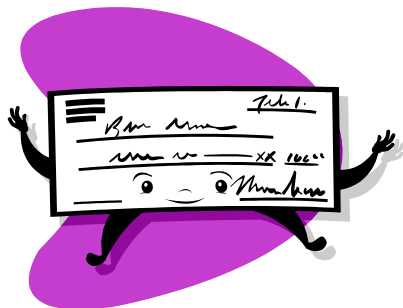
- Tithe: A set portion regularly given to the general church fund collected each Sunday service
- Offering: additional gift above a tithe given to support various church ministries

Types of Gifts Received

Cash: US currency placed directly in the “offering plate” or sealed in an offering envelope with name, address, and phone number. (Only the sealed envelope can be recorded for tax purposes)

Checks: Checks need to be written out to *New Life Community Church* or *NLCC* and the Memo: *Tithe*.

Checks are returned if a Direct Budget line item or a person name is listed in the memo line.



What are the different ministries I can give an offering to?

(following are Tax deductible)

Elder Fund: A fund to help the members and regular attenders of our church during financial hardship

Faith Promise: A fund separate from “missionary support” to help church supported missionaries with unexpected expenses. Faith promise is also use to help unwritten short term mission teams being sent from the church

Youth Scholarship Fund: Fund set up to under write youth activities, camps, and registrations a youth would have to pay for an event.

Special Project: This is monetary donations to a church wide project, outreach, or fundraiser. (Special Projects are connected to vision and mission of the church)

What offering donations are not Tax Deductible?

1. Item donations of materials to the church or project
2. Paying personal or dependents registration fees for an event.
3. Giving money in a fund raiser where you receive good or service

FAQ:

1. Is Faith Promise how we regularly support the missionaries?
A. *No, Faith Promise is only for special situations. Regular Mission Support is given out of the General Fund.*
2. How do I donate special items such as Estate, Trust, or Assets?
A. *Make an appointment with our Business Team.*
3. When should I expect my giving statement for taxes?
A. *Expect Statement by end of January. Keeping business office of current address avoids delays.*
4. If I am member/regular attender and I'm experiencing financial hardship who do I talk to?
A. *Find an Elder to discuss the situation and process.*
